Sam Collett is a portrait, figurative and landscape painter living in Joseph, Oregon. He says, "The mixture of forested mountains, rural farms and ranches has become my artistic metaphor. Wallowa County is a constant source of inspiration; this land and its people are always an artistic challenge to me."

The objective of this two day workshop will be to teach the students concepts and methods for a better understanding of their visual field; to bring a greater clarity and objectivity to their visual focus and then transferring those observations to the picture plane. To give the students the tools for them to use when they are back in their studios working on their paintings or drawings, to critique their progress and help them work through the problems that will arise; and finally to give them the information to use to create stronger and more knowledgeable paintings and drawings.
